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## 1. Introduction

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PLEASE NOTE: The dealines for the next three issues will not be in accordance with the standard pace. This is because we want to work this around Easter. With issue 11, we're back on Fridays. I may be looking at moving the standard deadline time back from 2130 CET, to allow me to finish adjudication a bit earlier in the evening. Thoughts about this are welcome.

This time, I received orders from 31 out of the 36 teams. 29 of the 36 teams have submitted orders on time for all issues so far, so we have a dedicated core - good!

Rosedale Open is led by Lower Tadfield Apocalypse with 24 points, with Camarilla Divided and Grunts United following closest, with 21 points each. At the bottom, we find Fishwick Old Contemptibles with 7 points, Car Park Rangers with 4 points and Coventry with 2 points.

Crowbury Challenge is led in a three-way tie between the Ancients, New Bremen Cyberdruids and ANU FC. Both Pocket Valley Philosophers and Dead Dino Storage are just one point behind.

Bellaire Bataille is led by Grorud Grasshuggers and Rocking Harmonies with 9 points each, with Toy Town Rovers following one point behind.

The Barrhaven Tournament is led by Muppets with 11 points, with Mishima Zaibatsu one point behind. Trivial Brief Association and Algorion Wonderboys follow four points behind.

The luckiest team of Rosedale Open is Grunts United, followed by Jedi Order and Fishwick Old Contemptibles. The unluckiest team of Rosedale Open is Car Park Rangers, followed by Coventry and Sportfånarna United.

The luckiest team of the league extension is now Rocking Harmonies, followed by the Nightfall Dreamers and Shock & Awe. The unluckiest team of the league extension is Gangsters United, followed by Equipe de France and Satanic Wonder Hamsters.

The home advantage is still 8 VP. Match 15 and 16 of Rosedale Open, match 7 and 8 of the other leagues, and the quarter finals of the Pembroke Pocal, are played next round.

Your teams will be sent out soon.
