- 1. Introduction

First of all, let's welcome Jørgen Bjørnelv, Sean Cable, Egbert Ferreira, Daniel Ingesson, Luke Matthews, Seth Owen and Inge Simonsen into the fold! You're receiving this just to keep you up to date on the proceedings - there are no results yet (obviously) for your teams.

I have valid complete teams on file for Sean, Luke, Jørgen and Seth already, the rest of you need to submit your teams within the week (same deadline as the rest) - if you want help with it, I'm happy to be of assistance.

#### Season ending

This is the last issue of the season (except possible updates on status), and so far I've had two teams dropped by their managers, seven new players sign up, two players wanting to start new teams and three more players willing to start new teams. That makes 12 for a new division, but I'd like to see as many as possible of those last three positions filled with new players or people wanting to start new teams, rather than relying on players who would take another team if we have difficulties filling the division.

In addition, I'm looking for new managers for Algorion Wonderboys and Equipe de France - they will play in the Berkeley Conference, which means Eric Billot, Trond K. Botnen, Kent Rune Klungerbo, Steve Janecek, Simen Fure Jørgensen, Darius Molloy, Håvard Pettersen, Owen Riggs, Robin Ringström and Bill White are not eligible. Anyone else? They can be renamed and/or restarted if you wish.

Three players haven't told me whether they're continuing - If you are planning on dropping a team (except Algorion Wonderboys and Equipe de France), please do let me know as soon as possible.

For Bill White: If you would like to keep your teams in the event of shortage of space, do let me know - otherwise I'll move on to S&A if I run out of other space. Of course, you're more than welcome to join us again at a later point.

For Darius Molloy and Ian Moes: You have seats in the new division, please submit your new teams by the deadline.

For everyone: If you would like to restart your team (same rules as when you started) rather than continue with it as it is, you can. Send in your new team (or state explicitly that you want to go back to how it was when you started this season) within the deadline. If it's over 60 VP and I hear nothing, I assume you continue as is. If it's at 60 VP or under, unless I hear something, I will make the decision for you.

For players ending with more than one team in the same division: To avoid this being an advantage, you cannot choose lineup when they meet, and both teams will play harder than they usually do. If you don't like this, then you should leave one of them.

#### Questionnaire

The turnout on the follow-up questions were much lower than the first ones, but we can live with that. To summarize:

• Most people don't feel strongly about where this information is, some felt that league information and luckiest team should go to the end of the document. I have split it this

issue, and that may remain, if that's a solution endorsed by everyone (that'd mean no introduction unless something in particular is happening, like change of season).

- A standalone executable for Windows will be better than or same as a web submission form for everyone I heard back from.
- Sorting by divisions is generally not wanted.
- If we lack players for teams between seasons, rather than delay things, we should use AIs.

Of course, this means I should try to speed up the season transition process, so as you saw in the mail, I asked you to try to recruit players - and I'll put out season 2's first issue on the 30th of April if I can. The latest it's coming out is 7th of May - if I don't have the needed 48 teams by then, I'll let the AI and/or players willing to help out take the remaining teams temporarily, asking for replacements until they're filled.
