Lower Tadfield Apocalypse still tops Rosedale Open, with 24 points. Sale Savoyards and Grunts United follow closest, five and six points behind, respectively. Blitzball Team and Jedi Order (11 points apiece) and Stranraer Reserves (1 point) make up the relegation zone. The luckiest team of Rosedale Open is now Saturday Morning FC, while the unluckiest team is still Call of Cthulhu. All the clubs submitted.

Mishima Zaibatsu still tops Lexington League, but with 24 teams, just one point ahead of Monkey Business and two points ahead of Dangermouse. The relegation zone looks fairly established, with Car Park Rangers at 7 points, Marvel Comics at 6 points and Coventry at 4 points.
