So, it's that time again - the season is drawing to a close, and I'd like feedback from each of you as to whether you're playing your teams onwards. Such feedback can be made contigent

upon whether your teams land together, just explain it to me so I can make the season transition as smooth as possible. If you know someone who could deserve a seat in this wonderful game, now's a good time to start bringing them in! :)

Three teams have a rather firm grasp of the Rosedale Premiership medals now, but things can still change over the last two weekends. The teams are Mishima Zaibatsu (31), The 5 Percent Community (26) and Sleep Wanderers (24). G.I.D. are closest with 21 points. In the relegation zone, we find Car Park Rangers and Twin Peaks Owls with 12 points each, and Les Gaulois with 11 points. Two teams at 13 points mean the relegation fight is anything but over. Les Gaulois are still the unluckiest team of the Premiership, whereas The 5 Percent Community hang on to the luckiest crown.
