14. GM's ramble

Three managers silent this time as well.

We're nearing the end of the season, so I'd like to hear back from you with regards to whether you want to continue with all your teams or if you want to drop some. Now is also a good time to tell potential new players about the game. I'm sure we can find room for your friends :)

The title race in the Premiership is now down to two clubs, with Mishima Zaibatsu far ahead of G.I.D. These clubs plus FC Asskickers have the medal positions for now, but Sleep Wanderers are only three points behind third place. Other clubs look too far behind to compete. In the relegation race, Car Park Rangers will relegate for sure if they don't win their last four matches, and even if they do, survival seems unlikely. The other relegation spots are still uncertain, though, but will most likely go to two out of Extreme (15), FC Mokum (15), Alphabet FC (14), Twin Peaks Owls (14) and Kremlin (12). With Kremlin's purchase this week, perhaps

they can climb to safe ground? Twin Peaks Owls are in trouble, though, with three suspensions in the key match against Alphabet FC. Sleep Wanderers is the only truly lucky team in the Premiership, whereas both Alphabet FC and Kremlin have had more bad luck than SW's luck. Truly, two unfortunate teams.

In Lexington League, it will be very surprising if the top three spots don't go to Studs First FC, First Men of Rome and Fjortoft's Friends. The latter two will fight for the second place, while the Legbreakers will promote from first place. Slartibartfast FC, Tamriel Athletic and the Ages are all five points behind second and third, so it is possible for them to catch up if one of the top teams have a bad finish of the season. At the bottom, Greensleeves United are already relegated to Berkeley Conference, but every team from fourth to eleventh could still follow them down. Studs First FC are by far the luckiest in this division, whereas Thinkers FC, Greensleeves United and Toga Boys have been rather unlucky.

Berkeley Conference features the closest race for first place. FC United have one point on Dummys, while Sheffield Thursday and Springfield United are three further points behind. Ladida FC are also part of the top race, with one point less than Sheffield and Springfield. In the relegation race, nothing is decided yet. Brazil Star Conquerors are struggling the most, having 10 points and four up to safe ground, but Call of Cthulhu at 12 and Sjokoladen Bk and PSV both with 14, are nearby. Harestua IL and Saturday Morning FC both have 16, and could be caught if the bottom teams finish well. In Berkeley, Dummys and Sjokoladen BK have been most fortunate, while Call of Cthulhu have had most of the bad luck.

Frackers FC still top Kirkwood despite losing to Professors of Jazz this round. With a four point lead to Dead Dino Storage, they will be hard to catch with just four games to go. In third place, Al Rassan United follow, two points behind DDS. Gamblers United are closest, three points behind third place. Team Tobbi are hopelessly lost at the bottom of the table with just two points, with St. Helens as their table neighbours with 12. Aa Fotballklubb are in tenth with 13. Whereas nobody have been terribly unlucky in Kirkwood, Dead Dino Storage have had most of what there was. Luck has primarily gravitated to Aa Fotballklubb and Gamblers United.

Sleep Wanderers are still luckiest, now followed by Dummys and Sjokoladen BK. The worst luck is now that of Alphabet FC, followed by Call of Cthulhu and Kremlin.

The home advantage has increased to 9 VP. In the next issue, rounds 19 and 20 will be played.
