14. GM's ramble

This time, four managers did not submit.

With one round to go, Mishima Zaibatsu have already made sure of the gold medals. This is the first time ever this club takes the league championship! They are also qualified for the final, so we'll see if they join the double club. G.I.D. and FC Asskickers will battle it out for second place, G.I.D. having a two point lead and at least in theory, easier opposition. In the battle for third place, Sleep Wanderers join the loser of the two aforementioned clubs. As for relegation, Kremlin have now joined Car Park Rangers on the way down. It is impossible to

save themselves even with two wins, because either Twin Peaks Owls or Extreme will have to get points from those teams' internal matchup. Alphabet FC might also plausibly get relegated, while only incredibly far-fetched theory can relegate FC Mokum. Sleep Wanderers are still the only truly lucky team in the Premiership, while Kremlin have now distanced Alphabet FC as the unlucky ones of the top flight.

In Lexington League, Studs First FC and First Men of Rome have already promoted, while Fjortoft's Friends just need two points to make sure of their own promotion. If the latter stumble, Tamriel Athletic can snatch third place with two big wins. Greensleeves United and AZ are already relegated, while Desassossego Blues look likely to follow them. However, the Blues may still catch Feyenoord, Erkrath Gladiators or Thinkers FC, and send one of them down instead. Call of Cthulhu are two points ahead of them and also need a good last weekend, whereas Sjokoladen BK, Harestua IL, PSV and Saturday Morning FC are the other teams that might go down a level. Coventry could, too, if they decide to lose by ten goals or so, both remaining games. In Berkeley, PSV and Sjokoladen BK have been most fortunate, while Sheffield Thursday and Call of Cthulhu have had most of the bad luck.

Frackers FC still top Kirkwood, and have now won the division even with two games left to play. Congratulations! Dead Dino Storage will also promote, either from second place or third place. Al Rassan United just need one point to follow them, while Gamblers United is the only team that could snatch the third place from behind. Luck has primarily gravitated to Aa Fotballklubb and Gamblers United, whereas bad luck have recently gravitated to NotReallyNewBremenCyberdruids.

PSV are now luckiest, followed by Sjokoladen BK and Sleep Wanderers. The worst luck is now that of Kremlin, followed by Sheffield Thursday and Call of Cthulhu.

The home advantage is still 9 VP. In the next issue, rounds 21 and 22 will be played. In addition, the Rosedale Knockout final will take place.
