Despite the missed penalties, Daniel Ingesson's team had little trouble considering the scoreline - but considering the expected score, it was a very even game.

14. GM's ramble

Six managers were silent this time. I guess late December isn't the best time to find time to do orders. Now it's early January, though, so you don't have that excuse anymore!

The three teams in the top of the Premiership now have a gap of three points from third to fourth, but who gets what medals is far from decided - and teams may catch up from behind with a real great end season surge. Mishima Zaibatsu tops with 31 points, whereas FC Asskickers with 29 and Fjortoft's Friend with 28 are the primary rivals for the Championship. First Men of Rome are outsiders for medals with their 25 points, whereas Blue Revolution and their 23 might take bronze if only Hell freezes over. In the relegation zone, we find Tamriel Athletic with 10 points, G.I.D. with 9 points and Sleep Wanderers with 6. Fjortoft's Friends remain luckiest, Gangsters United remain unluckiest.

Ladida FC are just about ready for the Premiership, as is The Ages. They lead Lexington League with 28 and 27 points, respectively. Dummys currently hold third place with 21 points, but Extreme also have 21, and Springfield United, Sheffield Thursday and Car Park Rangers each have 20 points. Even Kremlin with 18 and Erkrath Gladiators with 17 have vague hopes... In the relegation struggle, Slartibartfast FC are ready for Berkeley with their one point, Thinkers FC are practically the same with 10, whereas Feyenoord with their 13 need a strong end-season run to survive, having four points up to safe ground. Car Park Rangers are still luckiest in Lexington, whereas Feyenoord are still unluckiest.

Dead Dino Storage has now distanced even theory - they cannot finish lower than second place, even with four games to go. I can't remember anyone dominating a division like that, but my memory may be failing me. After DDS' 34, we find Desassossego Blues with 28, which also is a very good pick for promotion. Gamblers United have 23 in third, whereas Al Rassan United and Frackers FC chase with 22 and 21 points, respectively. There was a little tossup in the relegation struggle this round, Coventry now hold safe ground with 10 points, on stronger goal difference than Dispelliarmus FC. PSV with 9 points and Greensleeves with 8 points just need a couple of point to make it, so it'll be a tight and exciting race all the way to the finish line. AZ are luckiest and PSV are unluckiest; more Smolders karma transfer, apparently.

Potato People are also promoted already - with 34 out of 36 possible points. Time Will Tell (28) and Call of Cthulhu (27) will also be incredibly hard to catch. Fantasy Finale are closest to doing so with their 21. Gunnar still hold the relegation spot, and even after taking one point this round, they still have three up to safe ground. Sjokoladen BK are now luckiest, whereas Professors of Jazz are now unluckiest.

Luckiest of all is Fjortoft's Friends, followed by Car Park Rangers and First Men of Rome. The unluckiest is now Gangsters United, followed by two Jaap Smolders teams; Feyenoord and PSV.

The home advantage has increased to 9 VP. In the next issue, rounds 19 and 20 will be played.
