14. GM's ramble

Four managers did not submit orders this time.

In the Premiership, Blue Revolution still lead Mishima Zaibatsu, now with two points. These two teams face off in the next round... Dummys are closest, but three points behind Mishima Zaibatsu. In the relegation zone, we find First Men of Rome with 13 points, Famous Battles with 10 points and Extreme with one point. However, Ladida FC also have 13 points, just with better goal difference. The Ages remain luckiest, whereas Extreme now should've had nine points and have been treated to just one.

Springfield United still lead with three points down to Kremlin, while Sleep Wanderers remain five points behind. Lots of teams chase right behind, so the promotion battle isn't decided yet. It seems three teams are starting to look like relegating: Al Rissan United (10), Tamriel Athletic (7) and G.I.D. (7). The only team reasonably within reach is Gamblers United, but
