14. GM's ramble

Four managers did not submit orders this time.

It's that time of season again... let me know if you want to leave any teams or continue with them. From those I don't hear from, I will use my judgement based on how many deadlines were missed this season by the club, and what's best for the league system. If you're interested in taking over a team and/or starting a new one, let me know.



The medals of this season seem to be narrowed down to four teams - Blue Revolution (32), Mishima Zaibatsu (30), Dummys (28) and FC Asskickers (25). The last round will decide in what order they end up. Featuring among other games Blue Revolution vs FC Asskickers and the prestigious Kraijenbrink derby. Extreme are already relegated, whereas the other two relegation spots are pretty much down to Famous Battles (12), First Men of Rome (13) and Ladida FC (15), although Twin Peaks Owls (17) can still theoretically be relegated. Dummys are now luckiest, while Extreme remain unluckiest.

Springfield United have now promoted to the Premiership, with Kremlin being the only team which can catch them. Kremlin need one point the last round to make sure of going up, while Sleep Wanderers, Desassossego Blues, Dead Dino Storage and Erkrath Gladiators chase right behind. In the relegation zone, we find Al Rasan United with 12 points, G.I.D. With 10 points and Tamriel Athletic with 7 points. Gamblers United with 14 may still be caught after losing both their games this week, and a key game next week will be Al Rasan United vs Gamblers United. Sleep Wanderers remain luckiest, whereas Gamblers United are now unluckiest. These two teams deserve about the same amount of points, but one is third and the other ninth.

Call of Cthulhu and Potato People are already ready for promotion from Berkeley Conference, while Time Will Tell lead the pack for the third place. Feyenoord, PSV and Harestua IL all have at least a theoretical chance of promoting. Two wins for the Professors of Jazz didn't help them enough; the best they can theoretically get is the tenth place. AZ with 12 points and Slartibartfast FC with 13 points can both still survive, as Thinkers FC and Saturday Morning FC on safe ground both have 15 points. Call of Cthulhu remain "lucky", whereas the Jazz have still been unluckiest - in a fair world, they would've been in 8<sup>th</sup> place now.

Kirkwood Showdown will be won by Fantasy Finale this season, as they now have five points down to the next team with two games to go. Night Owls have 28 points and a commanding position in the race for second and third, but with Team Tobbi (26), Sjokoladen BK (26) and Interchangeable Parts (25) chasing, they might still miss out on promotion. Ergodic Theorems can still theoretically promote too, with 22 points and four points up to third. St. Helens were the only team of the relegation race to take points this issue - one point. NRNBC meet both their rivals - St. Helens and Fenerbache in the last round, so if St. Helens manage a draw against the Cyberdruids, they're safe. Fantasy Finale are now luckiest, while Fenerbache remain unluckiest.

Sleep Wanderers are still luckiest of the league system, followed by Dummys and Call of Cthulhu. Extreme are still unluckiest, still followed by Professors of Jazz and Fenerbache.

The home advantage is still 9 VP. In the next issue, rounds 21 and 22 will be played. In addition, the Rosedale Knockout final will take place.
