14. GM's ramble

Hi all!

As I mentioned earlier, Jerry Struik leave us, and if someone else would like to take over the Ages, let me know.

With a knockout in the top deathmatch, Erkrath Gladiators now have four points down to second place, having dropped only three points on the first 12 matches. Blue Revolution follow closest, a single point ahead of FC Asskickers and Night Owls, the latter probably in a better position having finished both matches with Erkrath Gladiators. Three teams have now been singled out as in relegation trouble: Gamblers United and Ergodic Theorems have 6 points each, while the Potato People have 2. Twin Peaks Owls, holding the last safe place, have 9. Erkrath Gladiators are still luckiest, while Blue Revolution are now unluckiest.

Feyenoord remain on course for the Premiership, even with their lead shrinking from five to four points. Car Park Rangers hold the second place, with Sheffield Thursday and Sjokoladen BK one point behind. In the relegation zone, we find St. Helens (9), Fjortoft's Friends (9) and the Ages (6), but there are two teams on 10, so nothing's decided yet. Car Park Rangers remain luckiest, while Sheffield Thursday remain unluckiest.

Thinkers FC remain table toppers in Berkeley Conference, one point ahead of G.I.D. and three points ahead of Call of Cthulhu. Below the line, we find Saturday Morning FC and Sleep Wanderers, both with 6 points, and Frackers FC with 2 points. G.I.D. are now luckiest, while Saturday Morning FC remain unluckiest.

In Kirkwood Showdown, Professors of Jazz still lead, now having 21 points. Chess Masters in second have 19, while Magical World have 17. G.I.D. are now luckiest, followed by Thinkers FC and Erkrath Gladiators. Saturday Morning FC are now unluckiest, followed by Blue Revolution and the Potato People.
