Erkrath Gladiators are still on track for gold medals, but the lead is down from three to two points before the final week, meaning that FC Asskickers can still, at least theoretically, catch them. Blue Revolution and Desassossego Blues tie for third place, three points behind the Asskickers, so the silver medals are still theoretically within the reach for them. Night Owls are within range of the bronze medals too, so there's plenty of races to follow in the last weekend of the Premiership. A relegation race is not among them, though, as Gamblers United, the Potato People and Ergodic Theorems are all relegated to the Lexington League one week before the end. Desassossego Blues have now managed to overtake Erkrath Gladiators as luckiest team of the Premiership, while Blue Revolution remain unluckiest.

Lexington League will feature a veritable thriller for the championship in the last round, seeing as the top three teams all have 26 points. They are, in order of goal difference, Sheffield Thursday, Feyenoord and Car Park Rangers. Extreme (3 points behind) and Queen (4 points behind) may still snatch promotion if one of the top three stumbles. No teams ready for Berkeley yet, with six clubs still in the danger zone. Time Will Tell (16), Fjortoft's Friends (15) and St. Helens (13) are below the line, while Sjokoladen BK (18), Dead Dino Storage (18) and the Ages (16) are right above it. Springfield United is the only team we know for sure will remain in Lexington League for the next season! The luckiest of Lexington League is now Car Park Rangers, while Feyenoord are now the unluckiest.

Call of Cthulhu still lead Berkeley Conference one point ahead of Thinkers FC, and both these teams have already assured themselves of promotion and can concentrate on fighting over the Berkeley title with each other. G.I.D. are in the pole position to claim the third promotion spot, but Jirs Park Rangers, Drawmongers FC, Dummys and Famous Battles are still within range if they should fade in the final stretch. Saturday Morning FC got relegated this weekend, leaving Harestua IL (11), Sleep Wanderers (13) and Frackers FC (15) in a three-way race for the last safe spot. Frackers FC are now luckiest, while Saturday Morning FC are unluckiest.

In Kirkwood Showdown, Chess Masters have taken a firm hold of the championship, needing only one point in the last weekend to take it. Tamriel Athletic and Professors of Jazz are the two teams who can still catch them, and thus also the favourites to promote along with them. Magical World are two points behind and might contest, Team Tobbi are four points behind and may theoretically contest too. Interchangeable Parts caught up one point to the First Men of Rome this weekend, meaning only one point separate them in the deathmatch before the last two games. And if the Interchangeable Parts should manage one point more than First Men of Rome, they are likely staying up - they have a 12 goal lead in goal difference. Chess Masters are luckiest, while the First Men of Rome are unluckiest.

Desassossego Blues are now luckiest of the league system, followed by Frackers FC and Erkrath Gladiators.

Saturday Morning FC are still unluckiest, while Famous Battles overtake Blue Revolution for second place.

The home is still 9 VP. In the next issue, rounds 21 and 22 will be played. In addition, the Rosedale Knockout final will take place.
