1. Introduction

Hi all!

Here are the latest results. Please check for errors, and let me know if you find any!

I have decided to check the interest for a new, much more difficult challenge. So I'm asking whether you want to manage a club in nightmare mode; a Nightmare Club.

If enough interest is there, I will make sure to finalise the rules before the season break (hopefully and probably, I will publish them before or with issue 11). I'm curious about what can be achieved with such a club, but I feel we'll need a few such clubs to actually run this challenge. If interest is minimal, I'll shelve the idea for now.

The idea is:

- * The club gets 1 free VP per session, not 2.*
- * The club has normal access to discovering apprentices, coaching players, bidding on GMs auction/transfer list and non-league sales.*
- * If the club wishes to have access to sending match orders, transfer listing players and private trades, it must employ an assistant coach. Salary is 500 kKj, which covers all issues until the end of the current season.*
- * The club is not eligible for end of season prize money (top finishes league/cup) or television rights money. It will receive cash for session, wins and draws as a normal club.*
- * Nightmare Clubs are not eligible to face non-league clubs in the cup. If they're drawn against one, I will manually edit the draw to switch the non-league club with the first listed normal club that isn't facing a non-league club.*
- * Since moving to a Nightmare Club is not as enticing as moving to a normal club, any winning bid by a Nightmare Club will be increased by a 10 kKj per level as a sign-on bonus for the player. So for example, a F I 7 won by a bid of 916 kKj would instead cost 916 + 70 = 986 kKj.*

I have not made rules for creating such a club, because I wanted to see if there's interest first. But suffice to say, the new Nightmare Club will be weaker, older and poorer than a normal starting club, but with much more decision space for creating it.

A Nightmare Club can be created in addition to or instead of a current club you manage.

As the veteran players will know, this mode is named as an homage to a great former United league that was absorbed into Rosedale Open many years ago, the Nightmare League.

If you're interested in starting a Nightmare Club, please let me know. Also, any thoughts about the rules for such a club (the mentioned ones or others) are very welcome.

The early deadline for issue 8 is Friday October 3, at 21:30 CET. It's always Fridays at 21:30 CET.

Next issue, you send orders for:

- * match days 13 and 14 in the league (see section 12)
- * the Rosedale Knockout quarter finals (see section 13)

This round, the home advantage increases to 8 VP. The home team is listed first in the league schedule. All cup games are on neutral field (no home advantage).

In addition, as always, you send coaching. Optionally, you can also discover talents and buy/sell players.

Orders that reach me before the early deadline clearly marked «final» waive your chance to change them, in return for a cash bonus of 20 kKj to your club. Optionally, you can let me know your orders are «always final» - an option for those of you who never change your orders anyway.

By the time you read this, I have already sent out your teams. If you haven't received them by the day after the publication, please get in touch.
