

Evaporator housing, assembly


- Remove heater/air conditioner assembly complete with instrument panel ⇒ page 87-159.
- Heater/air conditioning assembly ⇒ page 87-165.

1 - Intake duct

- ◆ Removing and installing air flow flap ⇒ page 87-183
- Coat sealing surfaces of housing halves with silicone rubber before assembling

2 - Fresh/recirculating air flap vacuum unit

- ◆ Removing and installing ⇒ page 87-186
- 3 Top part of evaporator housing
- 4 Gasket
 - Glued into top part of evaporator housing
- 5 Evaporator
- 6 Retaining clip
 - Carefully pry off with screwdriver



7 - Intake ring

 Secured from turning by cast stud on bottom half of housing

8 - Bottom part of evaporator

 Coat sealing surfaces to upper housing half with silicone rubber before assembling

9 - Fresh air blower -V2-

Air flow flap, removing and installing

- Remove heater/air conditioner assembly complete with instrument panel ⇒ page 87-159.
- Remove flap motor V71 for air flow flap:
 - ◆ 1996 vehicles ⇒ page 87-146.
 - 1997 > vehicles ⇒ page 87-147.



- Separate intake duct -A- from evaporator housing ⇒ page 87-181.
- Press back both catches -B- and remove both bearings.
- Remove air flow flap -C-.
- Install in reverse order of removal.

Note:

Insert air flow flap correctly (longer side of air flow flap faces in direction of travel and the teeth of the bearing face down).
